

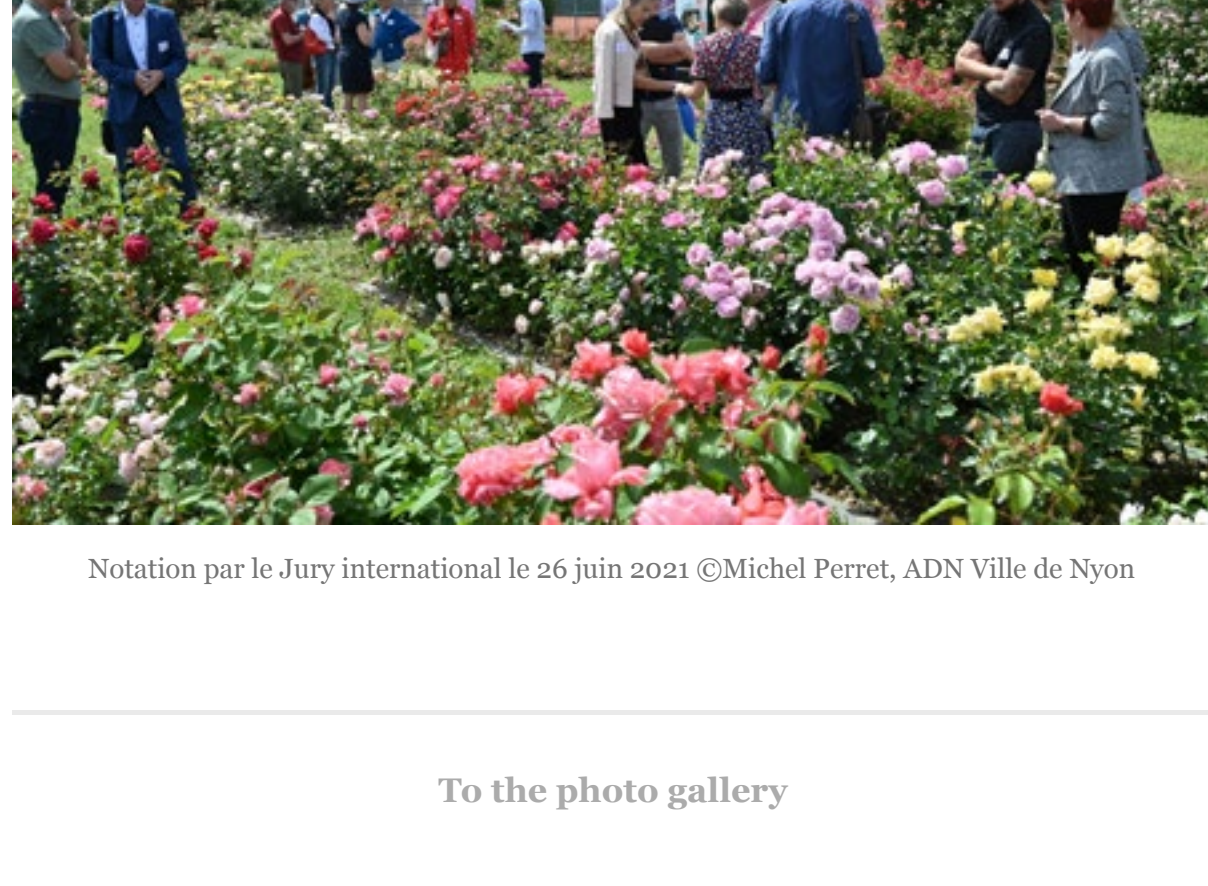


Great success for the 2nd edition of the International Competition of the New Rose of Nyon!

26 June 2021 will be remembered by the Swiss in general, and by the jurors and guests at the competition in particular. It was a great stroke of luck that this was the first day when the obligation to wear a mask outside was lifted in Switzerland. And it was a good thing, because it was also the day of the 2nd edition of the Nyon Competition, where meeting with your face uncovered while breathing in the scent of roses was fully appreciated.

AFTER THE RAIN, THE SUN

The weather in Nyon in May and June was particularly rainy: it rained on average at least two days out of three. The day before the Competition, the roses in bloom in the Competition roses were waterlogged and had to be cleaned of their damaged petals without being cut in order to appreciate their garden. Fortunately, the sun came out on the day of the Competition. The rose garden was therefore a beautiful place to welcome the international jury and the guests, who numbered around 100 in total.

THE WINNERS

Under the guidance of the President of the International Jury, Mrs Monique de Clarens, and the members of the permanent jury, the 90 varieties were evaluated by some 40 international jurors on the morning of the Competition. This evaluation (40% of the final average), coupled with the marks awarded during the 9 notations of the permanent jury (60% of the final average) during the two growing seasons for the hybrid teas, multiple flowers and miniatures; and the 14 judging sessions over three growing seasons for the climbing roses, landscape and ground cover, enabled the most deserving varieties to be crowned.

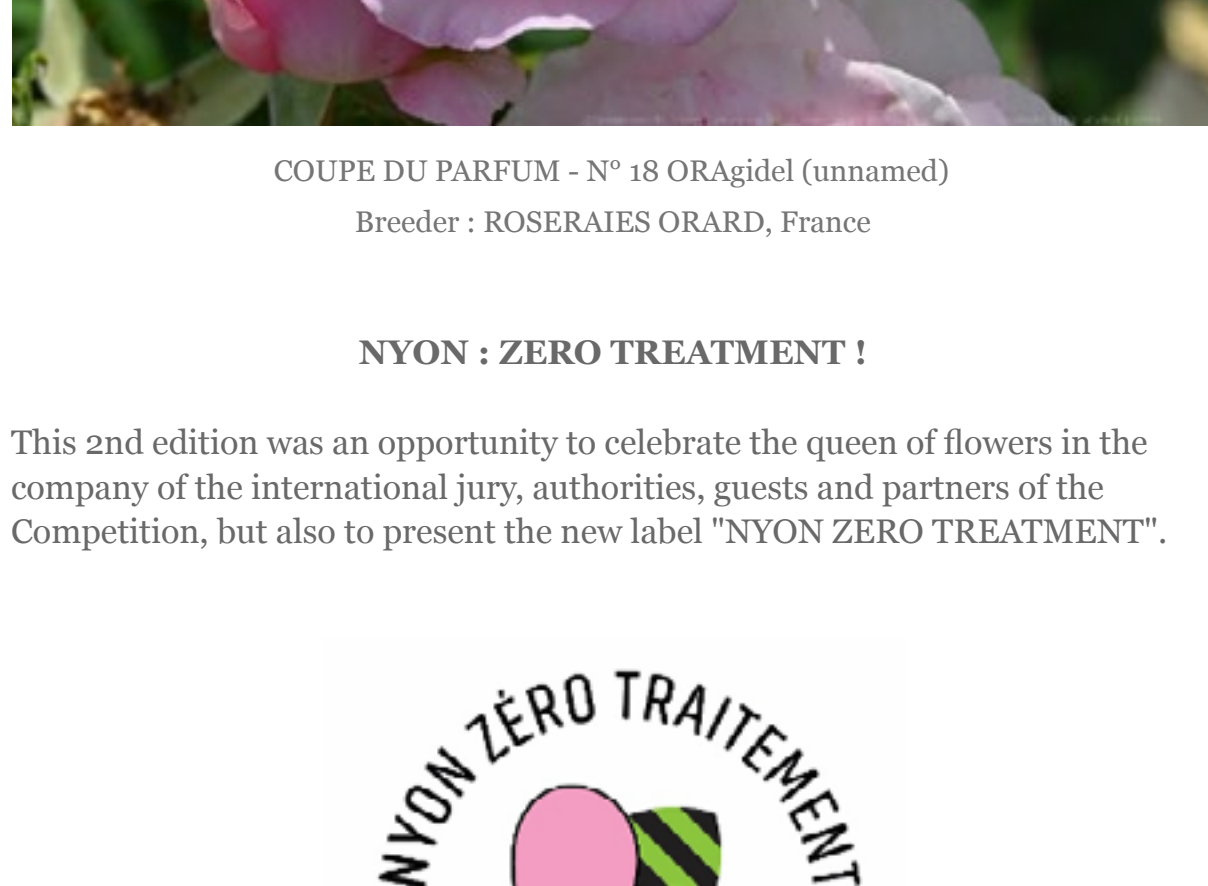
Thus, 8 gold medals, 8 silver medals and 17 certificates of merit were distributed by the President of the International Jury.

The variety 'Circle of Life®' by Rosen Tantau obtained the most points in all categories and was awarded the 'Golden Rose of Nyon'. The "Coupe du Parfum", offered by the Société Romande des Amis des Roses et de l'Horticulture SRARH, was awarded by the perfume jury composed of 3 specialists to rose n°18 (unnamed) from Roseraies Orard. This rose was distinguished for its "rose perfume par excellence, geranium, iris, violet, powder".



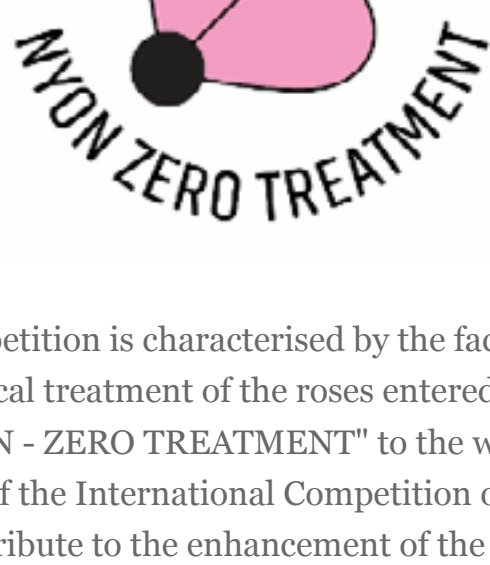

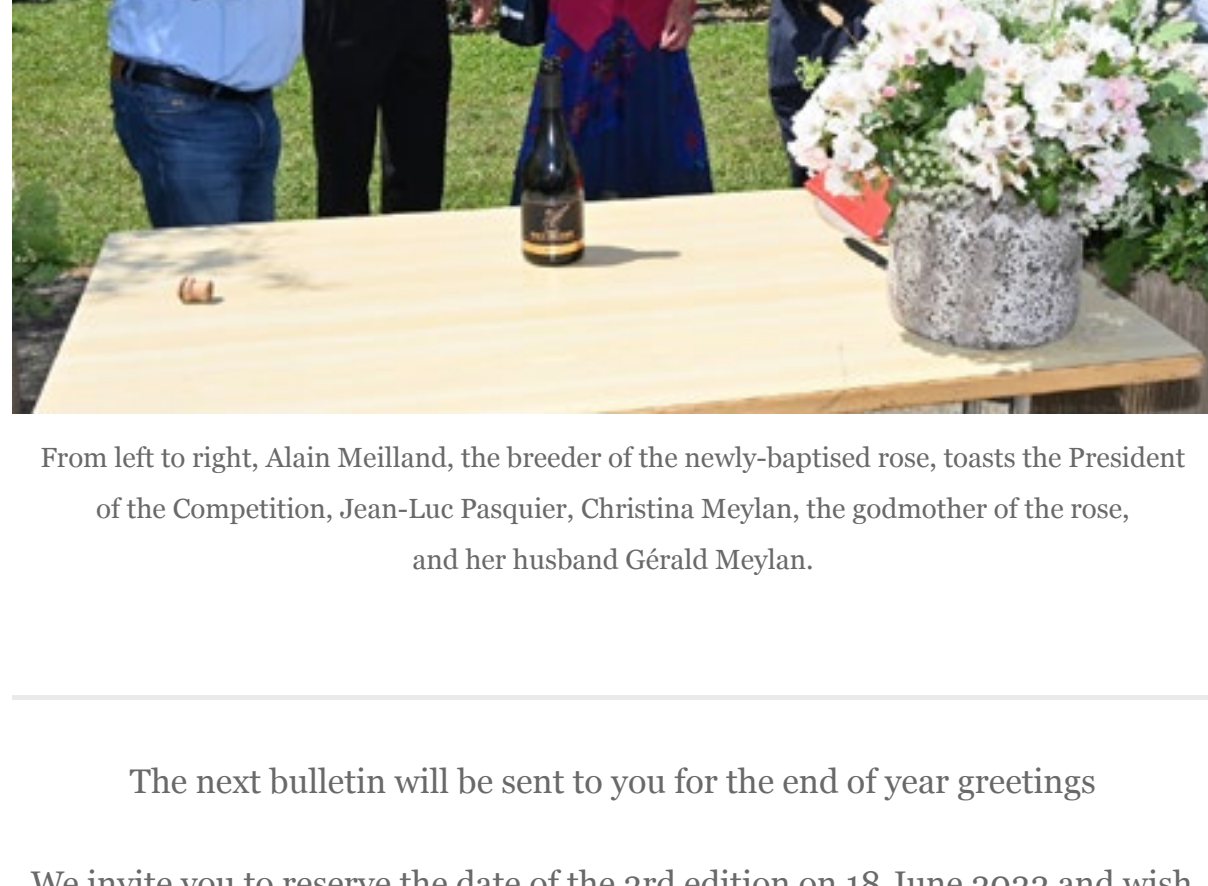

By affixing the label "NYON - ZERO TREATMENT" to the winning varieties, the organising committee of the International Competition of the New Rose of Nyon is pleased to contribute to the enhancement of the admirable work of rose breeders and the promotion of the queen of flowers, THE ROSE.

BAPTISM OF A ROSE

At the end of the judging of the roses, a rose was named in honour of Christina Meylan. This rose was offered by the breeder Meilland de France to the Competition Commissioner Mr Gérald Meylan to thank him for his unparalleled commitment. Indeed, after 55 years of serving the Queen of Flowers, Mr. Meylan has decided to retire from official duties. Mr Meylan preferred to dedicate this new rose to his wife. "Thanks to Christina, I have been lucky enough to be able to live this passion and it is to her that this honour belongs". This new creation SWEET FRIENDLY® 'Christina Meylan' from the FRIENDLY® range is a rose that corresponds to the values of the Concours de Nyon: a nectar-rich rose, very floriferous and extremely resistant to diseases and pests. Perfect for encouraging biodiversity and embellishing parks and gardens.
