

This final newsletter brings to a close the Concours International de la Rose Nouvelle de Nyon. As indicated at the end of last year, the organizing committee has decided to close the competition in Nyon due to a lack of personnel.

The 94 varieties planted were judged by the Permanent Jury in the summer and

autumn of 2024, plus visits this spring until June 11, 2025. The Permanent Jury awarded two gold medals, four silver medals and four certificates of merit. Please find below the list of winners, based on the scores of the permanent jury, the perfume jury and the 4th apprentice jury. Many of the varieties in this "zero-treatment" competition proved highly resistant and floriferous, despite the very unfavourable conditions of the first half of 2025.

went to KORDES ROSES N°23 'Zauberhaft' KORgrenewa, Germany, with 80 points. This rose seems totally resistant to disease and was judged to be "exceptionally floriferous". The apprentice jury made the same choice as the Permanent Jury, awarding the variety also the Prix des Apprentis (the Apprentices Prize) offered by Nyon's Human Resources Department. A permanent jury made up of two perfume specialists was augmented on the last day of judging by Mr. Wessel-Jan Kos, master perfumer. Mr Kos and the jury awarded two prizes. The "Coupe du Parfum", offered by the Société Romande des Amis des Roses et de

l'Horticulture SRARH, was awarded to the multiple-flowered rose N°16, 'DELparociane', from the breeder Société Nouvelle Pépinières et Roseraies Georges Delbard, France, and presented by Arnaud DELBARD; "This rose has an original fragrance with a beautiful blend of flowers, fruits and spices". The "Coup de cœur du parfum" award went to the N°67 climbing rose 'Zelmani's Dream' KORphieso, bred by Kordes Roses, Germany, and presented by Kordes Roses; "The fragrance of this rose is like its color, delicate and enveloping".







Switzerland. The apprentice prize, donated by the town of Nyon, was awarded to rose N°23, multi-flowered 'Zauberhaft' KORgrenewa from KORDES ROSES, Germany.

At the instigation of Mrs Gisèle Tschanz of the Tschanz rose gardens in Aclens, the Apprentice Jury was held for the fourth time on June 11. The jury was made up of ten young horticulturists in training, representing vocational training centers in French-speaking



l'Horticulture SRARH. From the outset, the Competition rules prohibited all treatments, both biological and chemical, in order to better respond to environmental challenges and the needs of gardeners. The first "limited edition" (COVID restrictions) took place with a restricted committee on June 20, 2020, the day after the relaxation of measures linked to the pandemic. The organizing committee then innovated with the creation of a zero-treatment label based on the aforementioned regulations, the setting up of an apprentice competition under the impetus and

Until 2025, the year of the last edition, 45 gold medals, 37 silver medals and 49 certificates of merit were distributed to the breeders who placed their trust in us during


